Tuition Overview 2025-2026

Admissions Timeframes:

In general, SELA's students begin attending in September for the start of the school year. However, we do maintain rolling admissions year-round and if after September 1st there is space available, we will offer it to families to start mid-year. For mid-year enrollments, tuition would be pro-rated to the child's start date. Note that the "full year program" cannot be pro-rated for an after September start date, and that a spot for a mid-year start cannot be secured until after September 1st.

Annually, SELA opens enrollment to current families during the month of December, giving priority to returning families and their siblings. Enrollment then opens in January for all new families, as well as for the Summer Program.

Waitlist:

Once classes are full, a waitlist will begin. To officially be added to the waitlist, an application and the fee must be completed through the TADS program. Feel free to check in to see where you are on the waitlist at any time. Note that these applications do not roll over from one year on the waitlist to the next. If you were on the waitlist for this school year and were not able to receive a spot, a new application is needed to apply for the next school year.

Payment Options: (finance charges may apply)

1. Full Tuition Payment: Due July 1st
2. Semi Annual Payment Plan: Due June 1st and Nov 1st
3. Monthly Payment Plans: Due on the 1st day of each month. Choose from four (4) to nine (9) month installment payment plans Begins May 1st annually or at the time of enrollment.

Schedule Changes:

SELA does have a very strict policy where we cannot reduce a schedule once the enrollment contract is signed, as we base our hiring and staff schedules on the number of students we have attending during the different periods of the day. If there is space available, we may add extra time/days to a schedule, but it cannot be reduced.

Siblings:

SELA offers a sibling discount of 10% off the 3rd child currently enrolled. New siblings enrolling are provided with enrollment priority during the December re-registration period for returning families.

A Kindergarten Preparatory program:

JuniorK students are fully immersed in Spanish throughout their day, and full-time students are introduced to a third language, Mandarin. The curriculum provides an introduction to Kindergarten level reading, writing, and mathematics, focusing heavily on exploration and discovery through thematic units and is aligned with the Massachusetts’ Kindergarten Common Core standards. Group Classes

SELA offers after school classes in a group setting. Each class will have a maximum of 14 children. Group classes run in two semesters (Sept—Jan & Feb—May) with 17 classes per semester. Parents will receive regular updates from the classroom and students will present a capstone project at the end of the second semester. Group classes are conducted fully immersed in the target language. Requires a minimum of 4 students to run a class. The enrollment deadline is Aug 27th.

The JuniorK Graduates Program

The JuniorK Graduates programs are specifically designed for former SELA JuniorK students to continue progressing with their Spanish skills. These classes have a max of 12 students in a group class, with a cost of \$2400 for the school year of a total of 34 classes.

JuniorK Graduates Level 1

This one-year program is designed for former SELA JuniorK graduates to further their study of Spanish, in a natural progression from where they left off at SELA. This class focuses on reinforcing language production skills (comprehension, reading, writing, and oral expression) by creating, producing, and learning the Spanish language in a fun, artistic and practical way!

JuniorK Graduates Level 2

This one-year program is designed specifically for those students who have completed the JuniorK Graduates Level 1 program. Level 2 continues to advance their Spanish study in a natural progression from what they've learned in JuniorK Graduates Level 1.

The Elementary Graduates Program

The Elementary Spanish Program is designed for students with a strong Spanish fluency base and who are looking to continue with more advanced grammar.

Beginner Elementary Spanish

Beginner Elementary Program is designed specifically for those students who have completed the JuniorK Graduates Level 2 program or have graduated from SELA's Kindergarten. This program has 3 levels within it for students to progress through at their own pace. The goal is for students to advance their Spanish study by focusing on literacy

Advanced Elementary Spanish

The Advanced Elementary Program is designed specifically for those students who have graduated from SELA's 4th & 5th grades. This program has 3 levels within it for students to progress through at their own pace. The goal is for students to advance their Spanish study with a higher emphasis on literacy skills, grammar, and correct conjugation and tenses of verbs.

16 Verbs Advanced Program

The 16 Verbs Advanced Program is designed for those students who have graduated from SELA's 6th grade and/or participated in several years of SELA's AfterSchool programs. The goal is for students to advance their Spanish study with a higher emphasis on literacy skills, and correct conjugation and tenses of verbs.

STATEMENT OF ENROLLMENT POLICIES

Su Escuela Language Academy LLC admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities made available to all students. Su Escuela does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies and programs. Certain accommodations will be implemented if acceptable documentation is provided. Please contact the Director for more information.

The SELA Admissions Agreement is intended to make the relationship with our families clear and to set forth the policies that govern that relationship. The Su Escuela Language Academy uses the TADS program for Admissions, Enrollment & Accounting.

TADS PROGRAM

Su Escuela requires all enrollees to create and use an account with “TADS” (www.TADS.com) a third-party service provider that provides online admissions processing, bill-pay and accounting services. TADS has its own terms of use and privacy policy, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated by reference as if fully restated here. You consent to the receipt of communications from TADS and Su Escuela via the contact information you provide.

LATE FEES

Su Escuela depends on prompt payment of tuition to provide the appropriate services and necessary resources to all our enrollees. A late fee of \$35.00 will be assessed and charged to your account by TADS or Su Escuela for any tuition payment not paid by the date due. I understand that if any tuition payment due remains unpaid for greater than thirty (30) days, my child may not be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities and/or school attendance until all amounts then due, including late fees, are paid in full. If you have difficulty paying tuition, please contact the Su Escuela Accounting Department immediately.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Flexible monthly, semi-annual and annual installment payment plans and the ability to pay tuition via check, credit card, or automatic withdrawals from a checking account may be available through Su Escuela or TADS. Tuition payments may be paid by check directly to Su Escuela for the following payment plans: Full Tuition, Semi-Annual, and Monthly Payment Plan.

INCORPORATED TERMS

This Enrollment Contract reaffirms and incorporates by reference the terms, conditions, policies and/or provisions contained in the Parent/Guardian Handbook and applicable program guide as if fully restated here. The terms and conditions stated in the Enrollment Contract shall control in the event of any conflict between the terms and conditions of the Handbook, Enrollment Contract and applicable program guide.

TERMINATION POLICY

SELA makes its hiring decisions, resource purchases, and budget based on the number of enrolled students. The addition or subtraction of even one student can require or eliminate the need for an additional classroom, teacher, and resources. Therefore, SELA must impose a strict termination and refund policy to ensure the needs of all students are appropriately met.

After an application for enrollment is accepted, SELA is unable to change a child's schedule. Space permitting, we may be able to accommodate additional attendance days to a schedule. This Enrollment Contract and a child's enrollment may be voluntarily terminated by a parent or guardian with written notice delivered by United States Postal Service Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, to:

SELA also reserves the right to terminate this Enrollment Contract and a child's enrollment if it is determined, in SELA's sole and exclusive discretion, that a child or parent/guardian has violated the Parent/Guardian Handbook. In the event of termination by SELA, written notice will be delivered to the address on file for the parent/guardian.

1. Enrollment will be terminated by SELA if the payment agreement is not completed and signed by the parent/guardian on or before the deadline listed in the agreement, however, the initial deposit(s) and any/all subsequent payments are Non-Refundable.
2. In the event of a termination by either a parent/guardian or SELA prior to November 30th, provided that notice of termination is not made during or within the fourteen (14) days prior to a Closure or transition to Virtual Learning in connection with a Force Majeure Event, 50% of the annual tuition will be waived. The Enrollment Deposit and any tuition paid prior to the date of termination shall be applied to the 50% of the annual tuition due, and any tuition paid more than 50% of the annual tuition will be refunded to the parent/guardian. The balance of the 50% of annual tuition shall remain due and payable in accordance with the payment plan selected.
3. NO tuition is refundable in the event of termination of this Enrollment Contract and/or a child's enrollment on or after November 30th. Parent/guardian agrees to pay any costs (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses) incurred by SELA in the collection of unpaid and delinquent tuition.
4. Upon receipt of the termination notification by either a parent/guardian or SELA, the contract and student's enrollment will be terminated effective immediately and the student will no longer be enrolled for attendance at SELA.

REFUND POLICY IN THE EVENT OF CLOSURE OR VIRTUAL LEARNING

Any one or more of the following occurrences (each a "Force Majeure Event") may result for a defined or indefinite period of time in the Closure of Su Escuela and/or a transition to Virtual Learning (to the extent offered to the applicable age group): (a) acts of God; (b) flood, fire, earthquake, hurricane, snow or snowstorm, tsunami, tornado, mudslide, weather conditions, or other natural disasters; (c) epidemics or pandemics (including, but not limited to, SARS-CoV-2 or "COVID-19", any derivative, evolution or mutation thereof or related or associated epidemics, pandemics or other disease, bacterial or viral outbreaks); (d) war, invasion, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), terrorist threats or acts, riot, explosions, protests, or other civil unrest; (e) government, administrative agency or licensing authority order, law, or action, (f) embargoes or blockades in effect on or after the date of this Agreement; (g) national or regional emergency; (h) strikes, labor stoppages or slowdowns, or other industrial disturbances; (i) blackouts, shortage of adequate power or transportation facilities; and/or (j) other events beyond the reasonable control of Su Escuela. "Closure" means Su Escuela (x) is unable, unauthorized, or incapable of providing its services to one or more age groups at or from its physical location and/or (y) has terminated its services to one or more age groups. "Virtual Learning" means educational services offered, in whole or in part, remotely by Su Escuela via digital audio-visual communications software and/or hardware. Su Escuela shall not be liable or responsible to Parent/guardian, child or their respective heirs, executors, representatives, successors or assigns, nor be deemed to have defaulted under or breached this Agreement, for any failure or delay in fulfilling or performing services or any term of this Agreement, when and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by or results from a Force Majeure Event. In the event of a Closure or transition to Virtual Learning in connection with a Force Majeure Event, tuition paid shall be non-refundable and the balance of tuition due at the time of the Closure or transition to Virtual Learning shall remain due and payable pursuant to the terms and schedule of any installment payment plan. Parent/guardian agrees to pay any costs (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses) incurred by Su Escuela in collection of unpaid and delinquent tuition.
